Due to the health emergency, Adams County Library is closed to the public. All programs are cancelled.

During the closure, library staff will answer questions by phone and email, and provide some basic services. Checked-out items may be returned to the Library at any time using the book drop at the back of the building.

Check-Out Service by Appointment

Starting immediately, Library patrons can call or email the library to set up an appointment for help with finding items to check out, obtaining tax forms, and general information. Items that need to be copied or faxed can be sent to the library digitally, then picked up at a time set up with a staff member.

Starting April 27, we will loan books, DVDs, CDs, and magazines to patrons with a valid library card. Items requested must be owned by Adams County Library, and available in the building. A call to the Library will help you find items you want.
