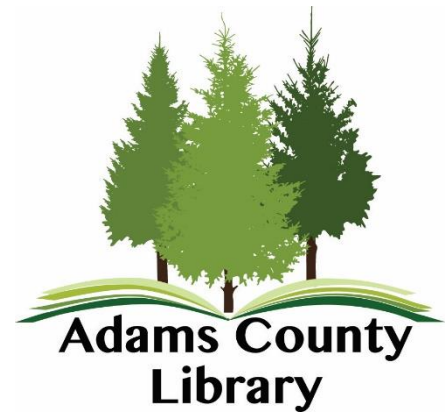


Adams County Library
